

Victim Videos With Background Notes

Three of the videos (Schuette, Guerra and Wright) were produced by the Center for the Army Profession and Ethics. One of the videos (DeMarchi) was produced locally at Fort Polk. All of the videos are intended for use in Soldier training on sexual assault and have been very well received. General Odierno used the Schuette video at the SHARP Summit in June 2013 with senior command teams.

Background on cases:

PFC Schuette: Five victims (including PFC Schuette) made allegations against a drill sergeant at Fort Jackson, SSG Luis Corral. PFC Schuette alleged that SSG Corral touched her vaginal area over the clothing and asked her for sexual favors. On November 14, 2012, SSG Luis Corral was convicted of five specifications of violation of regulations prohibiting relationships between drill instructors and trainees, five specifications of maltreatment of subordinates (sexual harassment), one specification of wrongful sexual contact, two specifications of indecent conduct, one specification of forcible sodomy, one specification of simple assault, and one specification of adultery. SSG Corral was sentenced to five years confinement, a bad conduct discharge, forfeiture of all pay and allowances and reduction to E-1.

PFC Guerra: PFC Guerra alleged that SPC Hines raped her in 1995. On August 27, 1995 SPC Hines was acquitted of rape and convicted of burglary and indecent language. SPC Hines was sentenced to a Bad Conduct Discharge, 30 days confinement and reduction to E-1.

SPC Wright: SPC Jarett Wright and a second victim alleged that four Soldiers hazed and/or sexually assaulted them. Two non-commissioned officers were convicted of three specification of violation of regulations prohibiting hazing, three specifications of maltreatment of subordinates, three specifications of assault, and three specifications of unlawful entry. Both non-commissioned officers were sentenced to two years confinement and a dishonorable discharge. A third non-commissioned officer was convicted of two specifications of violation of regulations prohibiting hazing, two specifications of maltreatment of subordinates, three specifications of assault, and two specifications of unlawful entry. That non-commissioned officer was sentenced to 120 days of confinement and reduction to E-3. A fourth Soldier, an E-4, was acquitted at court-martial of all charges.

PFC Demarchi: PFC DeMarchi alleged that SGT Jason Ingle raped her in 2007. SGT Ingle was acquitted at court-martial of the rape charges. In 2012, five additional victims came forward with allegations against SGT Ingle. Ms. DeMarchi testified at the court-martial in 2012 as a Military Rule of Evidence 412 witness to provide evidence of similar crimes. As SGT Ingle has already been acquitted of the rape allegation by Ms. DeMarchi, double jeopardy prohibited charging him with that offense again. On November 15, 2012, SGT Ingle was convicted of one specification of rape, one specification of wrongful sexual contact, one specification of attempted rape, two specifications of simple assault, and one specification of adultery. SGT Ingle was sentenced to 20 years confinement, a dishonorable discharge, forfeiture of all pay and allowances and reduction to E-1.
