| Do D | <p>DOD Legal Policy: On December 13, 2013, DoD SAPRO submitted a report to Congress IAW Section 573 of Public Law 112-239, the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) describing the plans and timelines for establishing Special Victim Capabilities (SVC) in each Military Department, along with an assessment of those plans and timelines.
