Hi Barbara -

Attached is a compilation of some of the most recent cases (redacted) in which assault survivors talk about the complications that ensued if/when they reported. Also attached is a Gillibrand press release which includes a letter from a retired Maj Gen, that supports removing these crimes from the chain of command. Additionally, attached please find advocate Nancy Parrish's SASC testimony that includes a statement from a commander who is not in favor of keeping the adjudication of these crimes within the chain of command.

I am still tracking down the Op Ed in WaPo from a General that ran last June that said the current

system was irrevocably broken and in need of change.

Regarding reporting, Israel after instituting the change we recommend found a huge jump in reporting:

In Israel, over a 5 year period from 2006-2011 reporting increased by 80%.

- In 2007, IDF Women's Affairs Advisor, Col. Rachel Tevet-Wiesel, received 318 complaints of verbal and physical harassment.

- In 2011, her office handled 583 complaints.

- The number of complaints that led to official investigations has climbed from 94 in 2007 to 144 in 2011.
