Dear Madame Chair and Panel Members,

The first public meeting of the Response Systems to Adult Sexual Assault Crimes Panel (Response Systems Panel), will take place on June 27, 2013. Below are the pertinent details to assist you in your travel.

- **Location** – The meeting will occur at the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, 333 Constitution Avenue NW, Washington, D.C. 20001. The panel will convene in courtroom number 20, which is on the 6th floor of the courthouse.
- **Schedule** – The meeting will start at 9:00 a.m. in the deliberation conference room with an administrative session that is not open to the public. There will be a continental style breakfast and coffee available for you. Mr. Bill Brazis, Deputy Director, Administration and Management, Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) will administer your oath of federal service. The public portion of the meeting will begin at 10:55 a.m. There are three sessions scheduled throughout the day, with a one-hour lunch break from 12:30 to 1:30. The meeting will conclude by 5:30 p.m. A complete agenda is provided in the attached materials.
- **Arrival** – If you are travelling to the courthouse by metro, you should use the Archives metro station. From there, proceed southeast on Pennsylvania Avenue, until you come to the courthouse. Once facing the main entrance of the courthouse, proceed around the left of the building until you reach the West entrance. You will be required to pass through security upon entering the courthouse. To ease your access through security, we have provided your information to the courthouse security personnel for pre-screening purposes. However, you should still allow additional time to pass through security. There will be a military officer or noncommissioned officer in uniform available to assist you and expedite your entrance as much as possible, but despite these preparations, there may be a wait to enter the courthouse.
- **Lunch** – We will provide a menu in advance so that you may pre-order lunch the day of the meeting, which the court's catering service will deliver by lunchtime. Additionally, light refreshments will be available during the afternoon.

The binder of materials provided to you contains background materials pertinent to the purpose of this panel to help you prepare for this first session. It is not intended to be a comprehensive resource; rather, it is intended to provide you general familiarity and background information. We will also send you a second binder of materials shortly, which is intended to

provide some deeper background information, but there will be much more information for you as the panel's work progresses. Everything provided to panel members is available to the public.




