### Statistics relating to sexual assault or misconduct

1. Statistics from the Australian Defence Force Investigative Service (ADFIS) relating to the number of sexual assaults and related offences reported to and investigated by ADFIS are only available from 2008 onwards. Statistics for 2013 are current to 11 September 2013.




