Dr. Christine Altendorf was selected to the Senior Executive Service in August 2009. She is currently serving as the Director of the Army's Sexual Harassment/Assault Response and Prevention (SHARP) Office. In this capacity, she establishes effective strategies, develops plans, and formulates policies for continued improvement of SHARP programs. She works with Army and DOD Senior Leaders to develop and execute short-term metrics and long-term initiatives to satisfy changing needs in a dynamic evolving environment. Prior to this assignment, she served as Chief of the Environmental Division at Headquarters, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. In this capacity, Dr. Altendorf oversaw the Corps environmental mission, and a team of professionals who enable its worldwide environmental responsibilities. The program provided technical management, design and execution of a full range of environmental protection, cleanup and sustainability activities. Activities include information sharing, lessons learned, communication and innovations across the entire Corps of Engineers, with government, non-governmental agencies, industry and academic partners and stakeholders.

She served as the Director, Joint Programs Integration Office, Headquarters, U.S. Forces – Afghanistan in Kabul from July 2011 through January 2012, where she was responsible for managing and maintaining oversight of a multi-billion dollar infrastructure program that includes roads, water and power. Dr. Altendorf also was responsible for Real Estate, Environmental and Operational Energy activities in the Combined Joint Operations Area-Afghanistan. She synchronized the efforts of professional civilians to program, plan, and provide infrastructure for U.S. and NATO deployed units and for Afghanistan's National Army and Police forces. She also oversaw the coordination of the Afghan infrastructure efforts of the Corps of Engineers with the U.S. State Department, U.S. Agency for International Development, other agencies of the federal government and the Government of Afghanistan.
