Gail Nutter Reid is a licensed clinical social worker with over 30 years of experience in the social work field. She is currently the Director of Victim Advocacy Services at TurnAround, Inc, the assault crisis center of Baltimore City and County which provides services to victims of sexual assault and domestic violence. She is a member of the Baltimore Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) and a board member of the Maryland Health Care Coalition Against Domestic Violence. Ms. Reid is an adjunct faculty at the University of Maryland School of Social Work. She also has a private practice in forensic social work, with a specialty in sentence mitigation.

Ms. Reid received her MSW from the University of Michigan and worked in Denver for many years in a variety of treatment settings – including inpatient, partial hospital, outpatient, and emergency crisis services – in both the public and private sectors. At the University of South Carolina College of Social Work, she developed the Collaborative Public Health Social Work Project, a graduate training program leading to the MSW/MPH dual degree. She has taught graduate social work students at both the University of South Carolina and the University of Maryland .
