Master Sergeant Stacia R. Rountree is currently a Track Data Coordinator and Enhanced Regional Situation Awareness Operator for Eastern Air Defense Sector /Detachment 1 at Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling, District of Columbia. EADS is one of two North American Aerospace Defense (NORAD) air defense sectors in the Continental United States (CONUS) and reports directly to First Air Force and the CONUS NORAD region, both collocated at Tyndall Air Force Base.

MSgt Rountree was born in Kalispell, Montana and raised in an Air Force family. In 1998, she enlisted in the Air National Guard. Her initial duty assignment was as a Tracking Technician for the Western Air Defense Sector, McChord AFB, WA. In 2000, she transferred to the Eastern Air Defense Sector, Rome, NY where she served as a Tracking technician, Identification Technician, Weapons Director Technician, and Senior Director Technician. She served as an instructor, simulation supervisor, and Bravo flight training NCOIC. In 2009, MSgt Rountree transferred to the Joint Air Defense Operations Center, Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling, Washington D.C. and served as the Operations Training NCOIC for EADS DET 1.

In 2008, the Eastern Air Defense Sector selected MSgt Rountree to become one of the units first SAPR Victim Advocates. She attended the National Guard Sexual Assault Response Coordinator and Victim Advocate Course at Camp Robinson, AR. When she transferred to Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling, she became a SAPR Victim Advocate for the National Capitol Region in 2010. MSgt Rountree is the most senior SAPR Victim Advocate at JBAB/Pentagon with more than 2,000 hours served. She is a SAPR trainer and co-chaired Sexual Assault Awareness Month for the AF NCR in 2011 and AF JBAB/Pentagon in 2012.
