that could have been construed as her knowing who may have raped PVT CLARKE. PFC [REDACTED] provided a Sworn Statement in which she contradicted many of the details of PVT CLARKE's account. (See Sworn Statement for Details)

About 1600, 3 Jan 04, SA [REDACTED] advised PVT CLARKE of her legal rights, which she waived, and provided a sworn statement wherein she admitted to having fabricated her original account. She then provided a second detailed account of the incident; wherein, she maintained she was raped (See Sworn Statement for Details)

About 1900, 3 Jan 04, PVT CLARKE telephonically notified this office she had found a picture of the individual who raped her on her digital camera, and advised she would provide it to this office. (See photo for details)

About 1250, 4 Jan 04, SA [REDACTED] coordinated with CPT [REDACTED] who identified the individual in the photo as SPC [REDACTED] Transportation Company, CAKU, a soldier in her company.

About 1300, 4 Jan 04, SA [REDACTED] advised SPC [REDACTED] of his legal rights, which he waived, and provided a sworn statement wherein he admitted to having consensual sex with PVT CLARKE, but denied raping her. (See Sworn Statement for Details)

About 1440, 4 Jan 04, SA [REDACTED] received a consent to search from SPC [REDACTED] for the search of his person. SA [REDACTED] then obtained a blood sample to extract DNA evidence on an FTA blood collection kit. (See consent to search for details)

About 1650, 4 Jan 04, SA [REDACTED] advised PVT CLARKE of her legal rights, which she waived, and provided no further information contrary to her second accounting of events. (See Rights Waiver for Details)

About 1830, 4 Jan 04, SA [REDACTED] traveled to Camden Yards, CAKU, and coordinated with CPT [REDACTED] SA [REDACTED] learned that CPT [REDACTED] had identified all occupants of SPC [REDACTED] tent and requested they all provide her with a statement documenting their knowledge of the events of 1 Jan 04. CPT [REDACTED] provided these statements to SA [REDACTED] (See statements for details)

About 1850, 4 Jan 04, SA [REDACTED] conducted a crime scene verification and collected evidence from SPC [REDACTED] tent.

Characteristics of Scene: SPC [REDACTED] lived in a General Purpose-Medium, military issue tent, with no windows and two Entry/Exits. It was located in the Camp Arifjan, sub-camp of Camden Yards amongst
