

IMPRESSIONS: Based upon the results of the present neuropsychological evaluation, Ms. Thundathil does demonstrate some evidence of cognitive dysfunction to include deficits in attention, concentration and working memory, memory impairment for both verbal and nonverbal information, slowing in her speed of cognitive processing, visual constructional abilities, verbal fluency, bilateral manual dexterity and motor coordination, and cognitive flexibility.

Given the current evaluation, it is likely that Ms. Thundathil experienced a traumatic brain injury during her sexual assault. It is also difficult to determine the role that her alcohol abuse and drug abuse might have played in her current cognitive dysfunction. In addition, Ms. Thundathil is currently experiencing significant emotional distress to include PTSD, as well as general anxiety and depression. It is quite likely that her emotional distress further exacerbates and complicates her cognitive status.

Ms. Thundathil is likely to benefit from imaging studies. She was also strongly encouraged to reschedule her appointment for her EEG. The results from those evaluations should be correlated with the results from the present testing.

Ms. Thundathil is strongly encouraged to continue her psychiatric and psychological care. Alleviation of some of her emotional distress will likely result in improvement in her cognitive functioning.
