

Captain Jason Brown serves as the Military Justice Officer, Military Justice Branch (JAM), Judge Advocate Division, HQMC.

Captain Brown was born and raised in New Orleans, Louisiana. In 2003, he graduated from the College of William and Mary in Williamsburg, Virginia with a Bachelor of Arts in English and a minor in Business Administration. He was also accepted for and attended a summer study program at Christ's College, Cambridge University, England in 2002. While attending Loyola University New Orleans College of Law, he attended the Platoon Leaders Class and received his commission in 2004. He then finished law school while he was in the Individual Ready Reserve and received his Juris Doctor in Civil Law in 2006. He was admitted to the Louisiana state bar in October of 2006. He is currently attending Georgetown University Law Center and is expected to graduate with a Master of Laws in International Business and Economic Law in February of 2014.

After working for the New Orleans District Attorney's office and as an assistant Officer Selection Officer in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, he reported for training at The Basic School, Quantico, Virginia in June, 2007. After graduation, he attended the Basic Lawyers Course at Naval Justice School in Newport, Rhode Island. In April 2008, he reported into Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, South Carolina, where he first served as Trial Counsel and Chief Trial Counsel. He then served as a Series Commander and Company Executive Officer for Lima Company, Third Recruit Training Battalion. Upon his return to the Depot Law Center, he served as the Senior Defense Counsel. From November 2010 to November 2011, Captain Brown served as the Headquarters and Service Company Commander and Battalion Judge Advocate for Third Battalion, Second Marine Regiment. He deployed with Third Battalion, Second Marines to Musa Qa'leh District, Helmand Province, Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom 11-1.

Upon redeployment to Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Captain Brown executed orders to Judge Advocate Division, Headquarters Marine Corps. He served as the Deputy Branch Head of the Judge Advocate Support Branch (JAS) prior to his current assignment.

Captain Brown's personal decorations include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal and the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (two awards). He is also the winner of the 2013 American Bar Association Young Lawyers Division Outstanding Young Military Lawyer Award.
