

Anne Munch, Esq.

Ms. Munch attended the University of Denver for her undergraduate and graduate studies and received a BA in psychology and sociology, and then her law degree. Following law school Ms. Munch spent thirteen years as a prosecutor in three different jurisdictions in Colorado. In addition to her work as a prosecutor, Ms. Munch was the director of the San Miguel Resource Center, a domestic violence and sexual assault program in Telluride, Colorado where she provided direct services to victims. She also directed the Ending Violence Against Women Project, a statewide multi-disciplinary training and technical assistance project in Colorado for nine years completing sexual assault, domestic violence and stalking training and technical assistance in all 22 Judicial Districts.

Currently, Ms. Munch is the owner of Anne Munch Consulting, Inc. and works full time providing speaking, training and consulting in the area of sexual assault, domestic violence and stalking. She is a recognized subject matter expert in her field, and provides her services to colleges and universities, local, national and military organizations all across the United States, Asia and Europe. She works extensively in the Sexual Assault Prevention and Response programs for the US Air Force, the US Army, the US Navy and the US Marine Corps. Ms. Munch co-developed the Bystander Intervention program for the US Air Force and the two-week Sexual Assault Investigations course for CID Army. Ms. Munch regularly speaks at state, national and international conferences on topics related to violence against women. She is on the teaching faculty for the International Association of Chiefs of Police, is a visiting scholar at The Women's College at the University of Denver, and is a part time municipal court judge in Lakewood, CO.
