Ms. Krepp joined the House of Representatives' Homeland Security Committee in 2005. In her role as Senior Counsel, Ms. Krepp advised members on homeland defense and maritime security issues.

Ms. Krepp served as Chief Counsel at the U.S. Maritime Administration and Special Counsel to the General Counsel at the U.S. Department of Transportation during the first Obama administration. She is currently a private consultant and professor at Pennsylvania State University.
