

# **MICHAEL F. LoGRANDE**

## **Deputy Director, Air Force Review Boards Agency and Executive Director, Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records, Joint Base Andrews, MD**

Michael F. LoGrande serves as Deputy Director, Air Force Review Boards Agency (AFRBA); a Field Operating Agency established to streamline the adjudication of military and civilian personnel matters through a total of 10 statutory and secretarial boards. The Agency reports directly to the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Manpower and Reserve Affairs (SAF/MR). One of those boards is the Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records (AFBCMR), where he served as its Executive Director. The AFBCMR is the highest level of administrative review within the Department of the Air Force.

Mr. LoGrande was a distinguished graduate from the United States Air Force Academy and was commissioned in 1986. He served in the Regular Air Force and Air Force Reserve for a total of 25 years and retired as a Colonel in 2011. Throughout his military career he served as an instructor pilot in trainer, airlift and tanker aircraft. When not serving in an operational role, he had four separate assignments in the legislative affairs community. His final assignment was as the Mobilization Assistant to the Director, Legislative Liaison. In between active duty assignments, he flew for a major airline.
