# Air Force Clemency & Parole Board Function and Authorities



Function – Remit, suspend, or reduce any unexecuted court-martial punishment (clemency) or conditionally release from confinement (parole/mandatory supervised release) inmates into the supervision of US Probation Officers

10 U.S.C., Chapter 48 (*Military Corrections Facilities*) (§§ 951 – 956).

DOD Instruction 1325.07, *Administration of Military Correctional Facilities and Clemency and Parole Authority*, March 11, 2013.

DoDD 1325.04, *Confinement of Military Prisoners and Administration of Military Correctional Programs and Facilities*, August 17, 2001 (certified current as of April 23, 2007).

Air Force Instruction 31-205, *The Air Force Corrections System*, Chapter 10 – Clemency and Parole, April 7, 2004 (certified current as of April 28, 2011).

# AF C&PB Snapshot

- **Primary work: risk management on behalf of Secretary**
  - **Conditionally release inmates** from confinement [parole / mandatory supervised release (MSR)] into supervision of US Probation Officers
  - **Grant clemency** (Remit, suspend, reduce any unexecuted court-martial punishment)
- **Generally, inmates eligible for conditional release after serving 1/3 of minimum 12-month sentence; annually thereafter**
- **Board considers: Everything -- conviction; confinement/parole or MSR record; victim impact**
- **AF is fully committed to Rehab programs whenever possible**
  - Increases morale; re-enters a rehabilitated member back to community
  - Protects society

  - Chief, Corrections Division, AF Security Forces Center (or HAF/A7S Rep.)
  - Chair/Exec. Sec., AF Clemency & Parole Board
- **Senior Legal Advisor, SAFPC**
