Minutes of April 17, 2014 Meeting via Teleconference

The Response Systems to Adult Sexual Assault Crimes Panel (RSP) is a federal advisory committee within the Department of Defense (DoD) operating pursuant to Section 576(a) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2013, the Federal Advisory Committee Act of 1972, the Government in Sunshine Act of 1976, and governing federal regulations. The Role of the Commander Subcommittee of the RSP held a meeting via teleconference on April 17, 2014, to discuss and deliberate on drafts of Parts IV and V of the Subcommittee's final report to the RSP entitled, respectively, Commander Responsibilities in Military Justice Cases and Legislation and Policy Affecting Commander Roles and Responsibilities in Sexual Assault Prevention and Response. The teleconference began at 3:34 p.m. and concluded at 5:15 p.m. at the RSP office at 875 N. Randolph Street, Suite 150, Arlington, VA 22203. 
